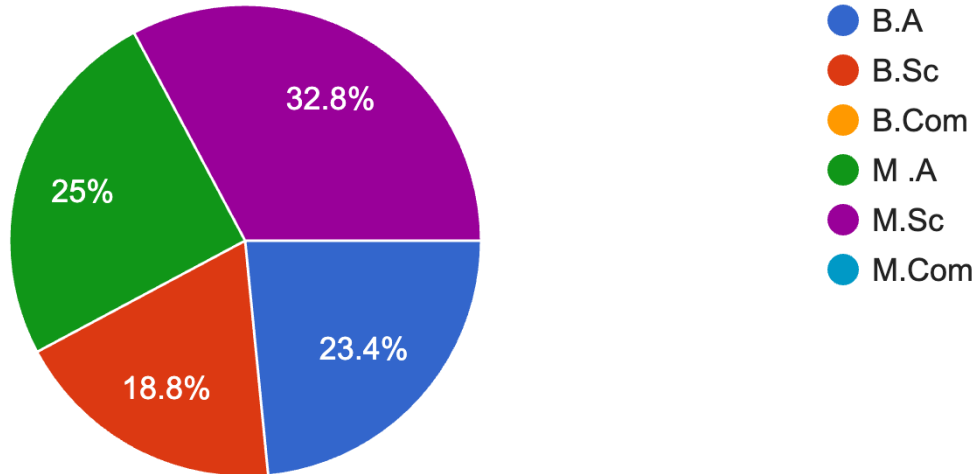

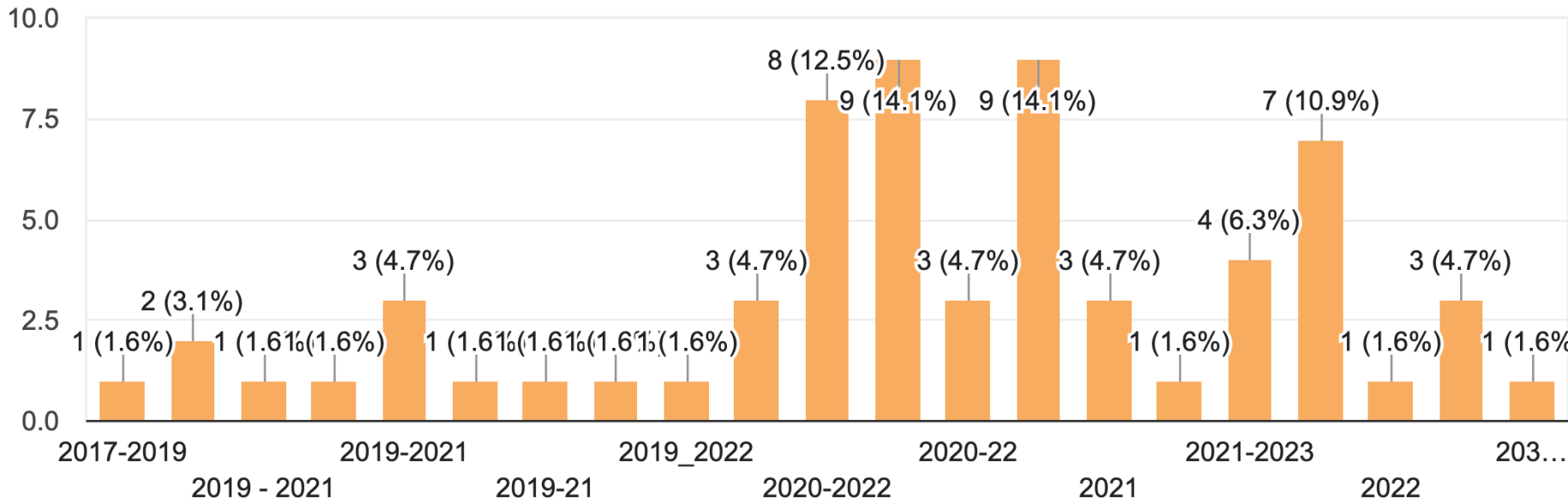

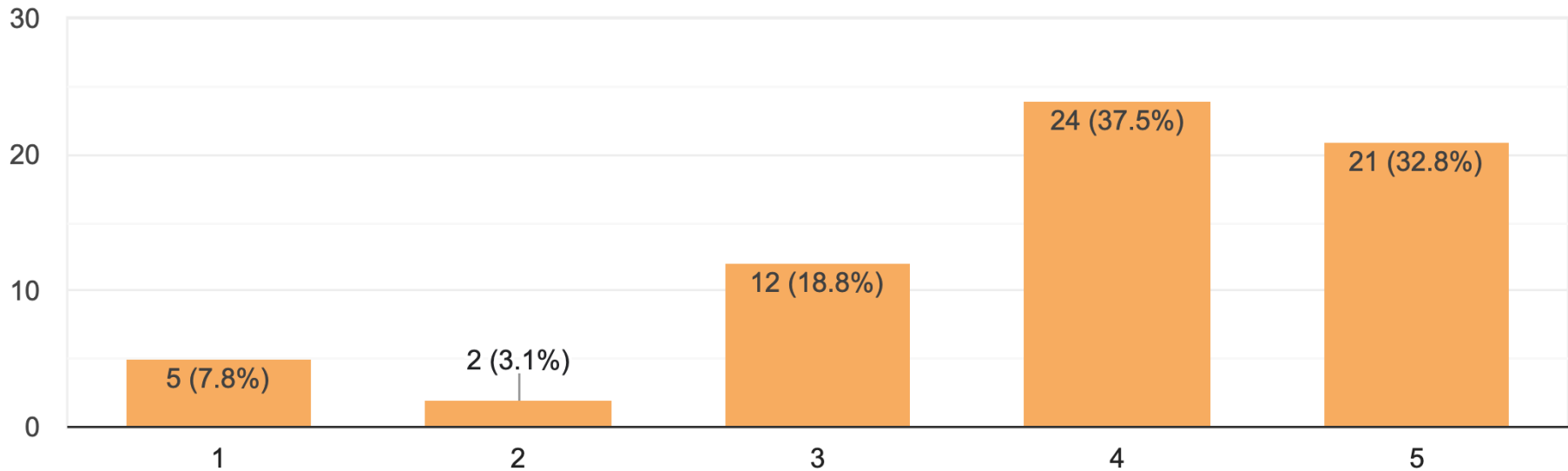

The syllabus has good balance between theory and application

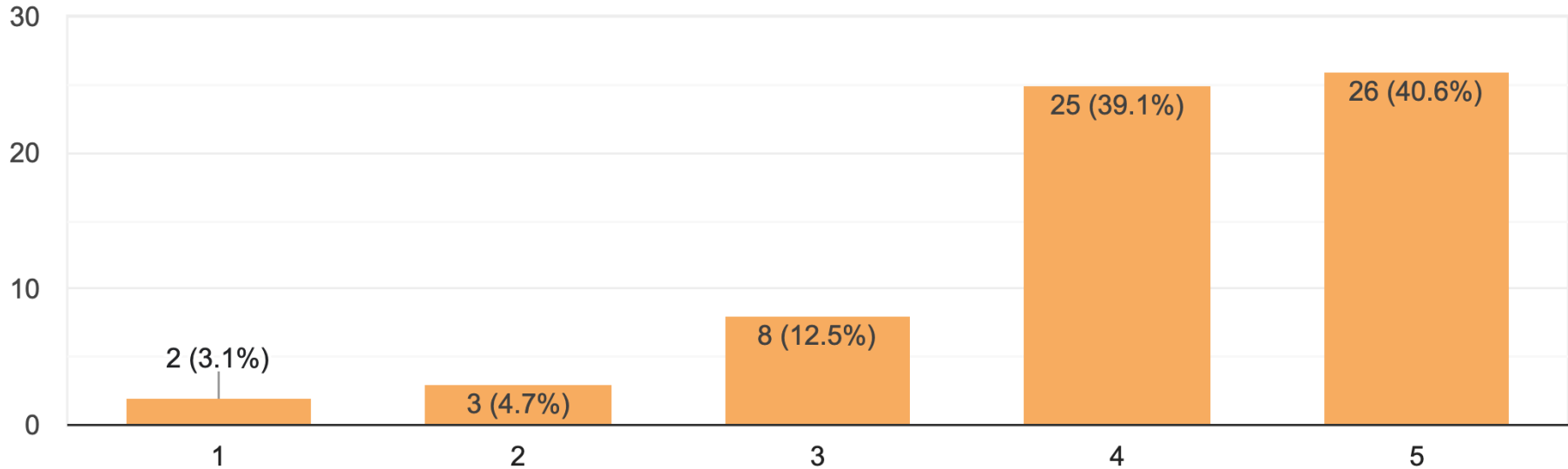

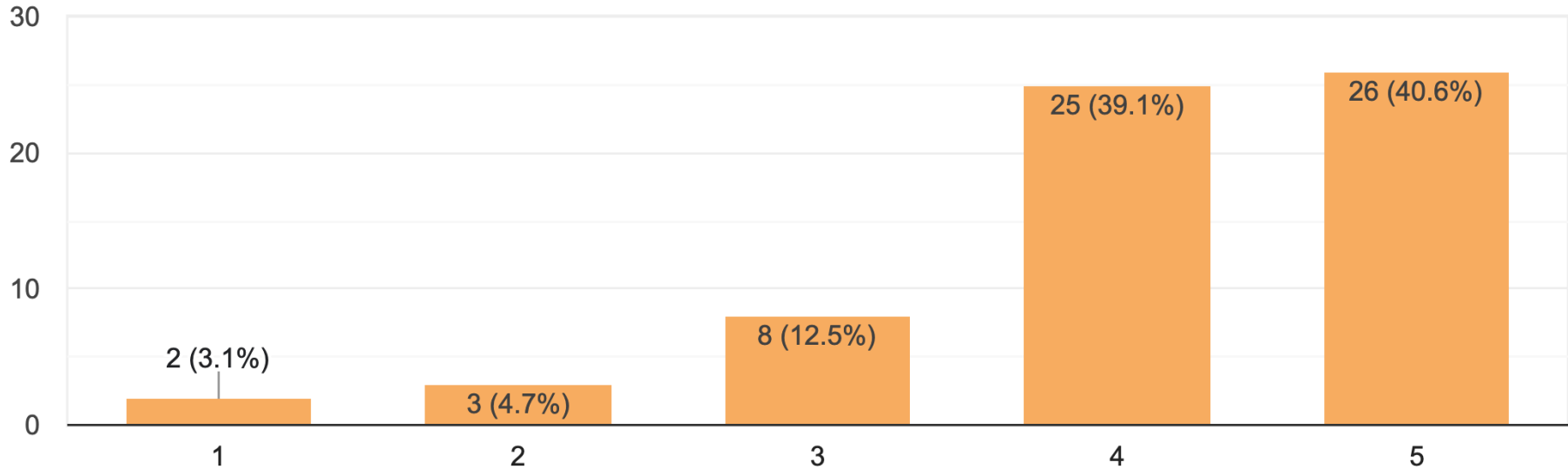

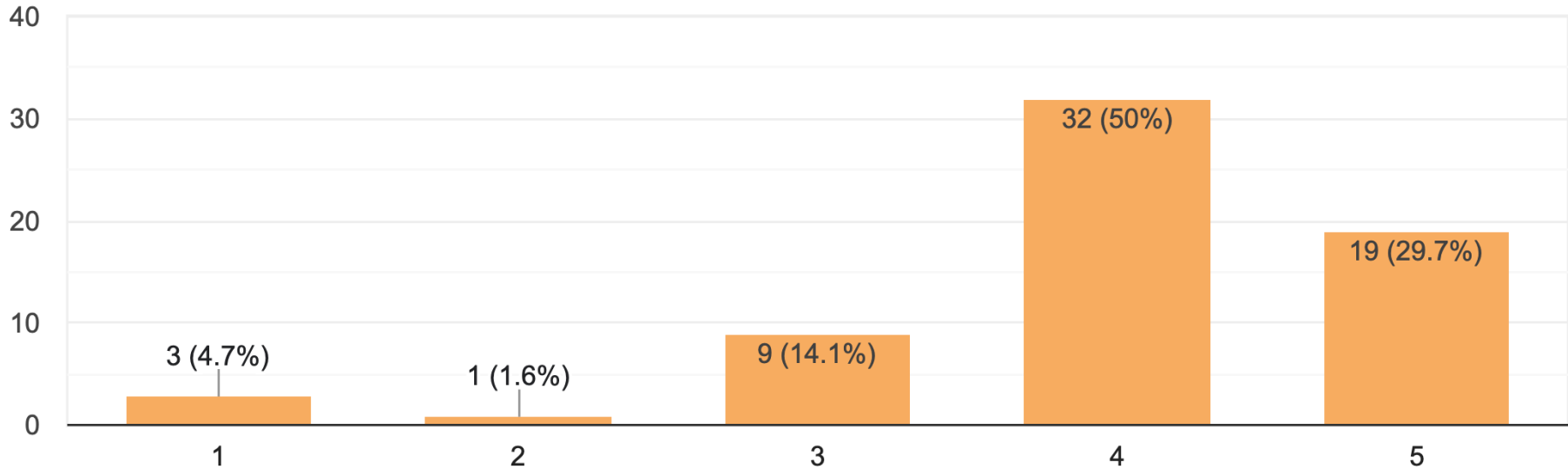

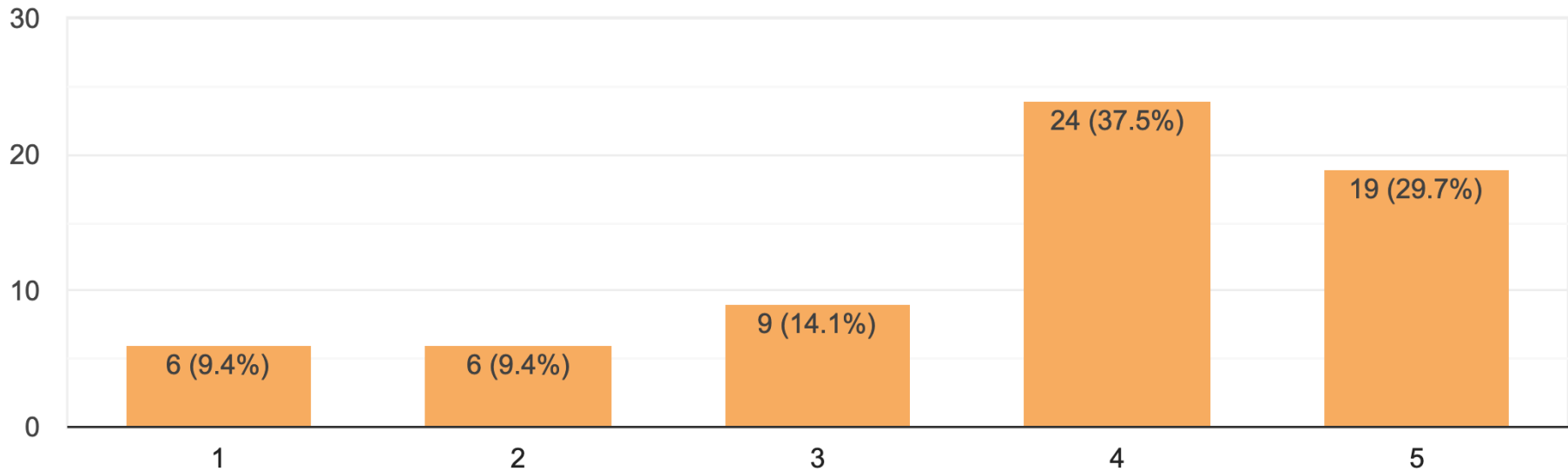

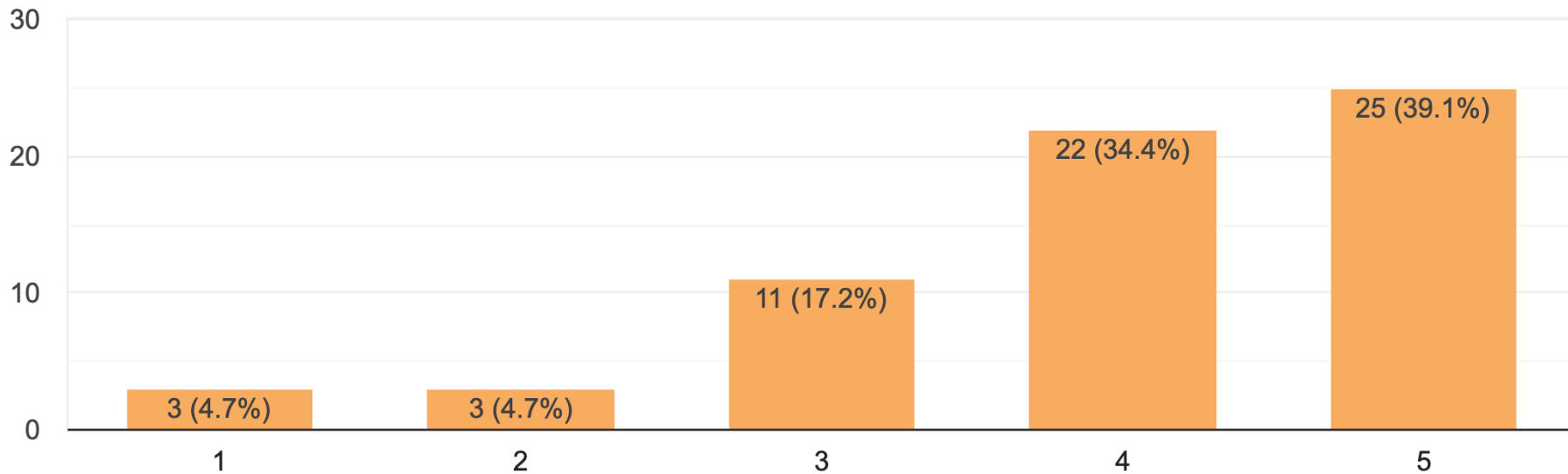
