The Co-ordinator shall make arrangements for inviting the external experts of ~~the~~ BOS, neighbouring institutions, industry and resource persons from other institutions.







The HOD reported that the list date for utilising the Autonomy Fund was extended to 31/12/2015 by the Govt. of Kerala.



Other Proposals


1. To propose an integrated PG Programme in Finance

Mr. Eugene George proposed vote of thanks to all the members of the Board of Studies and the meeting came to a close at 4.00 P.M.








