Annual Report (2022-23)

The National Cadet Corps is the Indian military cadet corps with its Headquarters at New Delhi. It is open to school and college students on voluntary basis. National Cadet Corps is a Tri-Services Organization, comprising the Army, Navy and Air Force, engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens. The National Cadet Corps in India is a voluntary organization which recruits cadets from high schools, colleges and Universities all over India. The Cadets are given basic military training in small arms and parades. The officers and cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course but are given preference over normal candidates during selections based on the achievements in the corps.

With the Moto of **“UNITY & DISCIPLINE”** Naval Wing NCC of our college has been started under 7(K) NU NCC Unit in 1954. Sanctioned strength of the senior division (SD) & senior wing (SW) cadets is 50. All activities of NCC will be unceasingly monitored by an Associate NCC Officer (ANO), who is one of the trained teaching faculty of the institution. Major activities and training of NCC consists of Institutional training, Camp training, Annual RD camp, attachment training, Social Service and Community development and Youth Exchange Program. All sorts of training will help in the empowerment of cadets in personal as well as in social life. Weekly parades and trainings are carried out by exploiting the amenities of Southern Naval Command, Kochi. A brief report of the training conducted during the academic year 2022-23 is given below

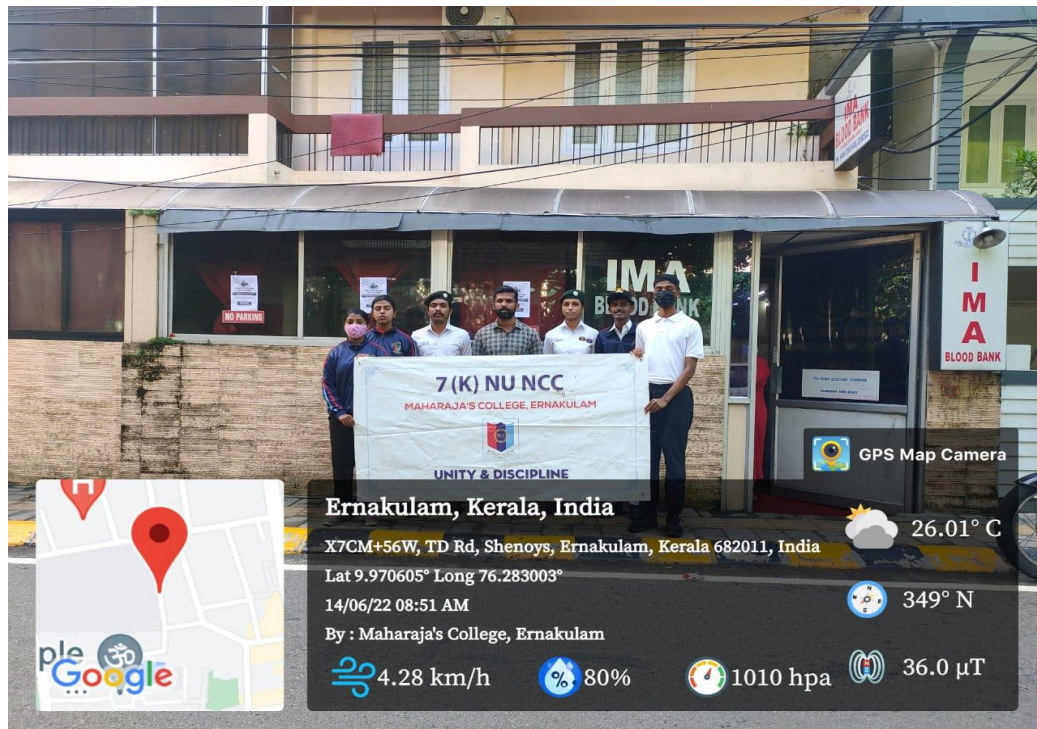

Activities Conducted during 2022-23

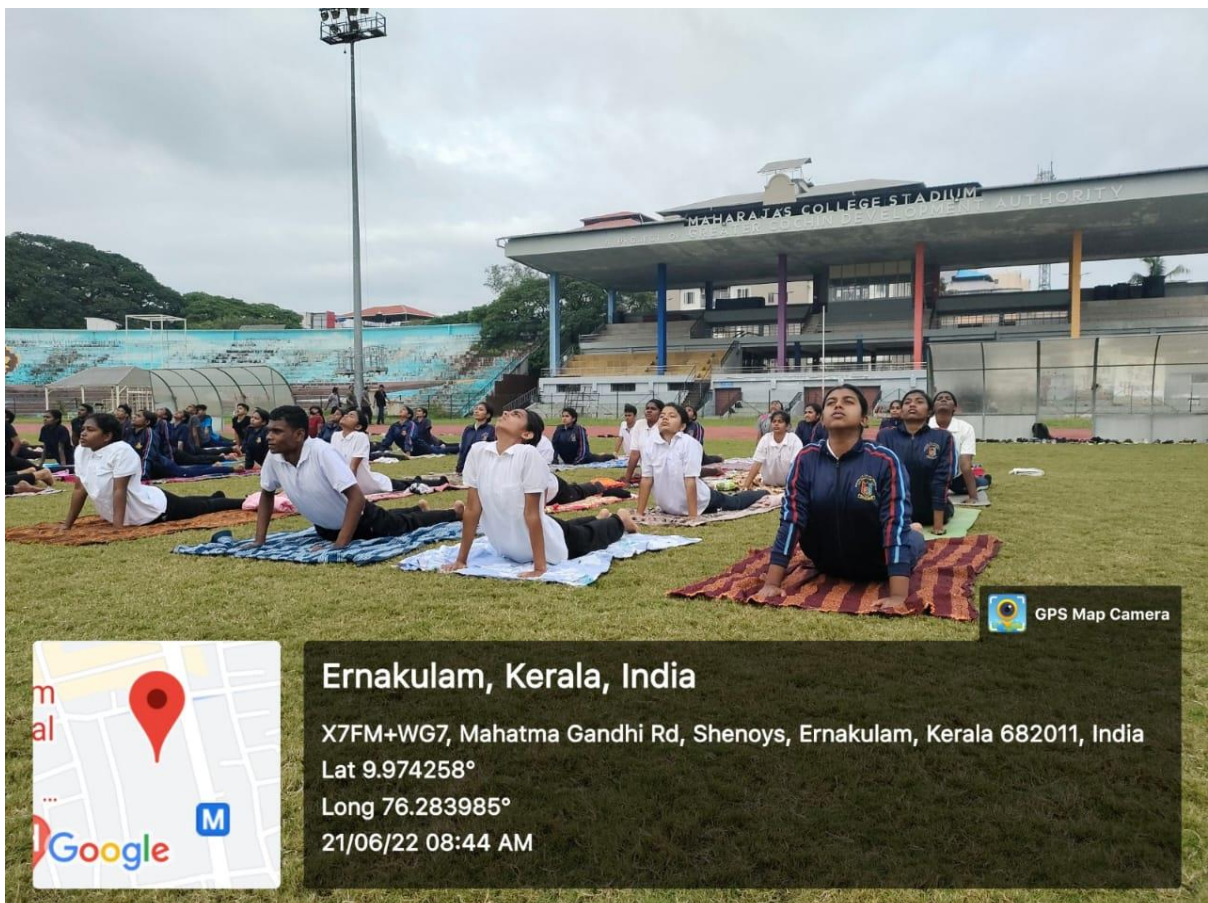

unit blood each thereby they expressed the spirit in volunteering as a blood donor in all emergencies.

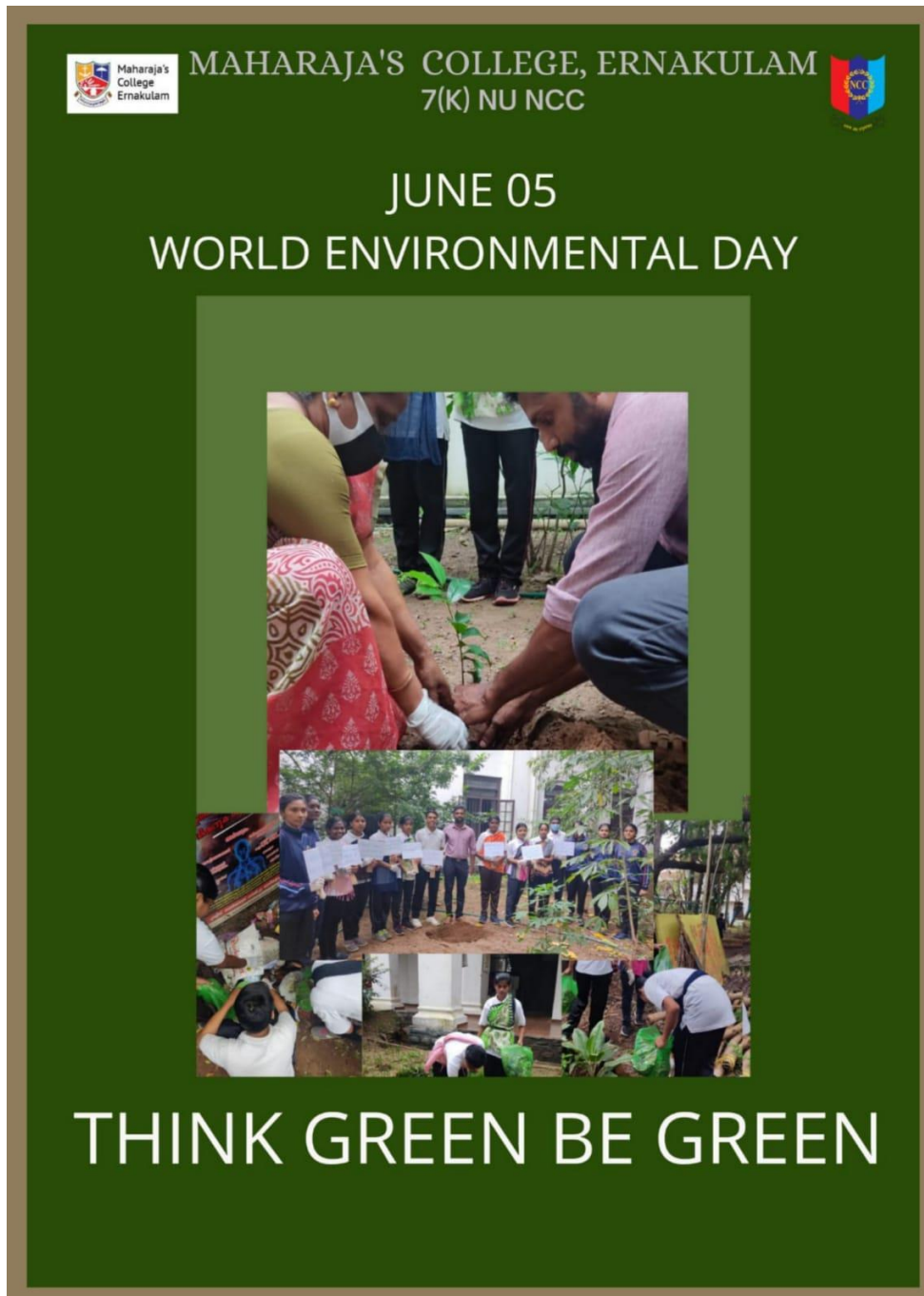
World Yoga Day Celebrations

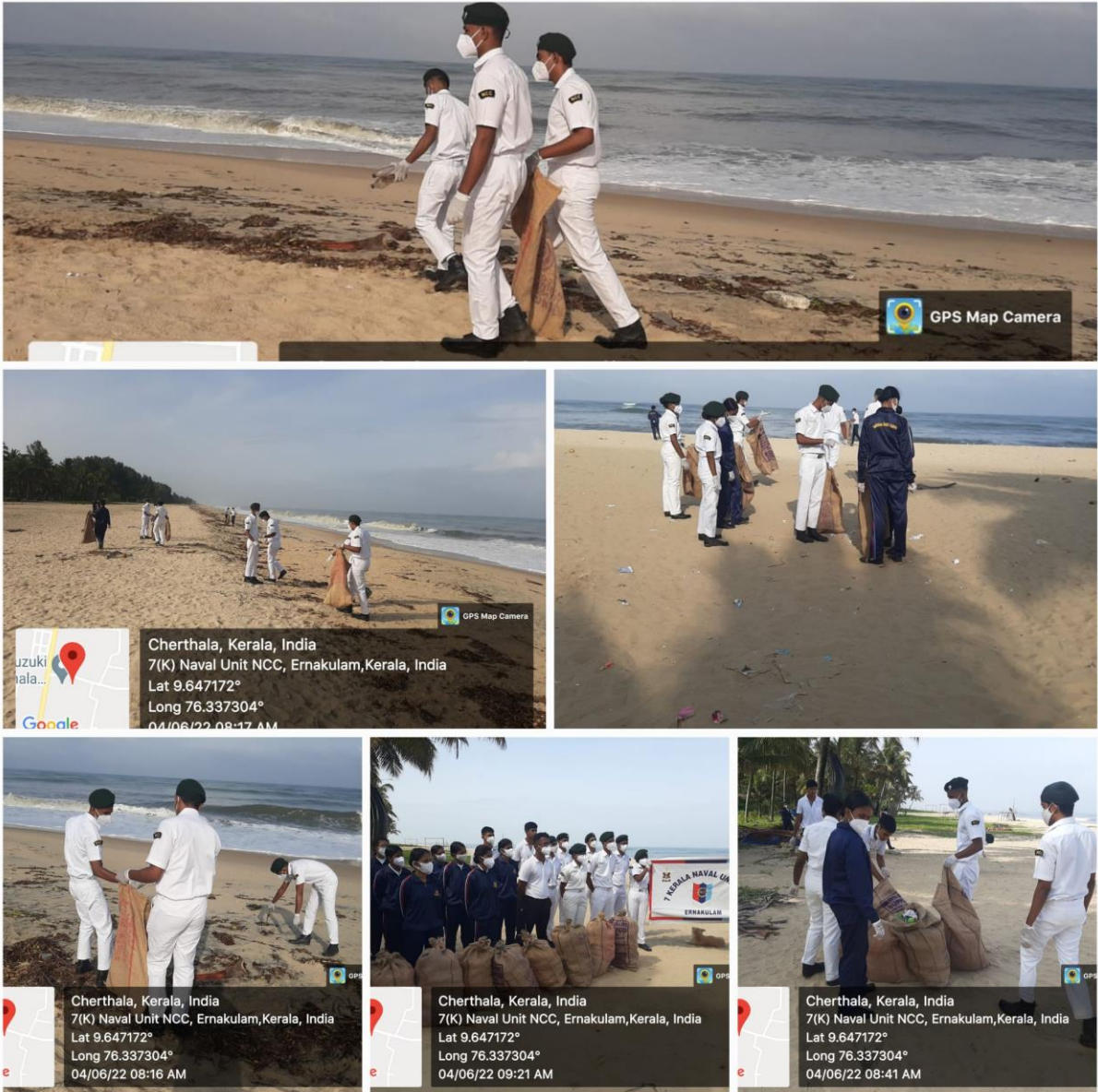
