




Screen shot of Online training class on garden making held on 05/11/2023

(Assistant Professor of Botany)	Carbon sequestration potential of tree species in Subhash Chandra Bose Park	Carbon sequestration potential of cities can be affected due to sizeable reduction in tree cover by major infrastructure projects. Ernakulam (Kerala) city is not an exception since many trees were cut down in the last ten years for various major development projects - metro rail, road expansion and building construction. Urban green space, particularly trees have a greater potential to sequester carbon from the atmosphere and mitigate the impacts of climate change in cities. Subhash Chandra Bose Park located in the heart of Ernakulam city is one such green space that forms a major hangout for the city dwellers. The present study is a sustainability initiative to inventory the tree species in the park and assess their carbon sequestration potential. The total tree biomass, total stored carbon, and CO ₂ removed by the trees were determined using allometric model/volume equations and compared. A total of 90 tree species belonging to 12 plant families were studied within the park covering 11.5 acres. The study revealed that <i>Cyrtostachys renda</i> was the predominant species in the park followed by <i>Roystonea regia</i> in number. Carbon sequestration potential was highest in <i>Peltophorum pterocarpum</i> followed by <i>Roystonea regia</i> . The present work will be helpful to evaluate the role of trees in reducing atmospheric carbon dioxide. The study recommends the necessity of green spaces with ideal tree species within the city to ameliorate the effect of climate change.

(Assistant Professor of Botany)	Assessment of drinking water quality of Maharaja's College campus	Drinking water quality affects directly human health. According to the WHO, tangible benefits to health can be obtained from access to safe drinking water. The study was carried out with an aim to investigate the quality of drinking water in Maharaja's College campus. The physicochemical parameters (colour. pH, conductivity, ammoniacal nitrogen, chloride, fluoride, sulphate, nitrate, hardeness, BOD, COD, calcium and moagnesium) and microbiological quality (total coliform and fecal coliform) of water samples were analyzed. Among five of the samples studied four of them met the recommended acceptable range by WHO except one that showed total coliform higher than the recommended level. Thus drinking water from four of the sources are good for drinking while the fifth source needs further purification treatment.

Harithakarma Sena is a volunteer organization formed in 2017 in collaboration with Harita Kerala Mission, Suchitwa mission and Clean Kerala Company which aims to promote environmental conservation and sustainable development in Kerala. The study was carried out to examine the socio economic back ground of haritha karma sena members, to analyze the various challenges faced by the harithakarma sena members and to analyze its importance. The study identified the lack of storage facilities for the waste collected from households as a significant problem. Some households showed reluctant attitude towards harithakarma sena. The study recommends the provision of storage facilities in all wards and better awareness and education for households on proper waste management. Overall, the study highlighted the need for effective solutions to overcome the challenges in solid waste management and the importance of supporting organizations like Harithakarma Sena to promote sustainable development and environmental conservation.




