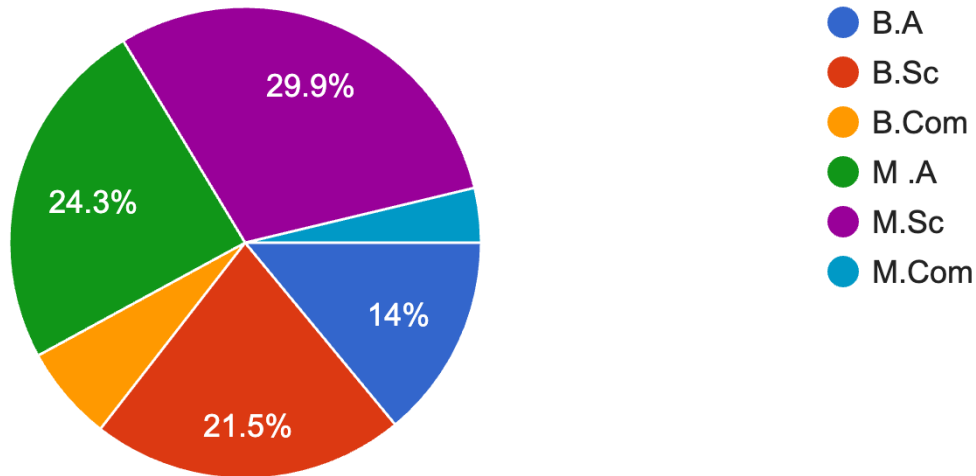

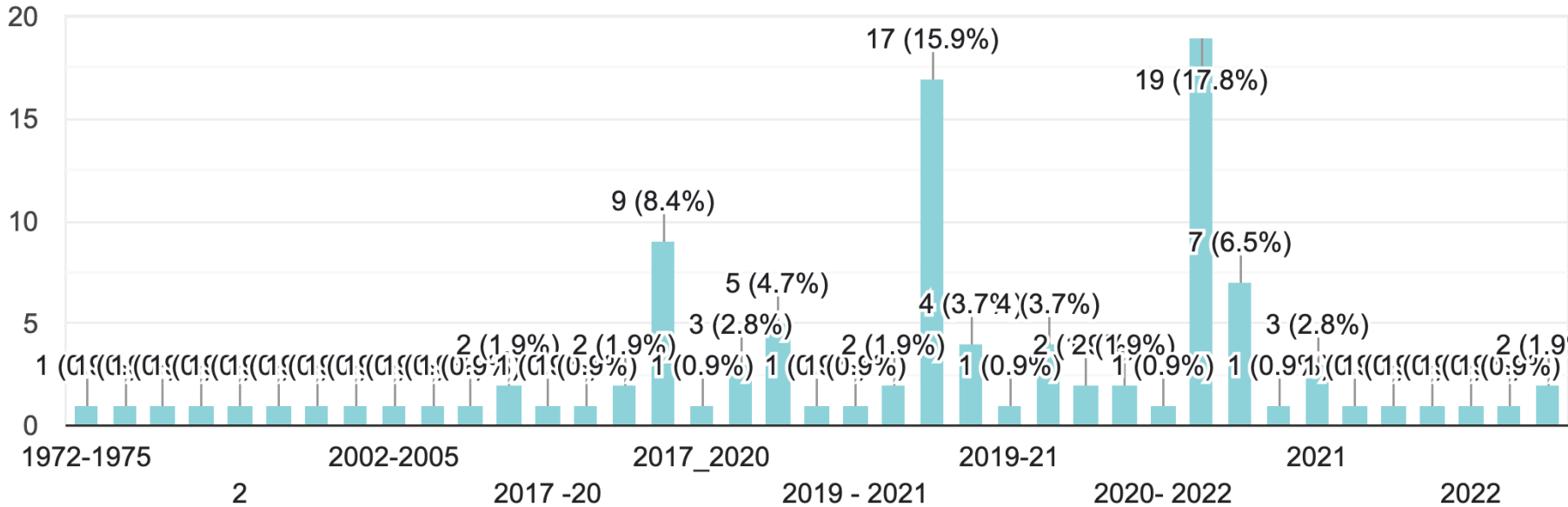

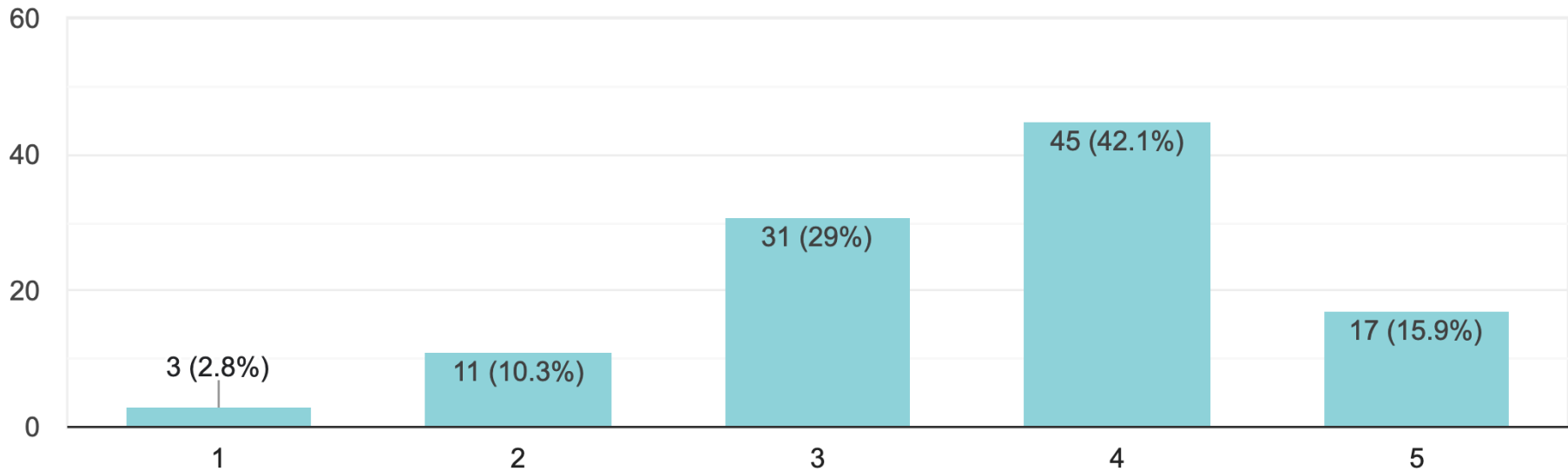

The syllabus has good balance between theory and application

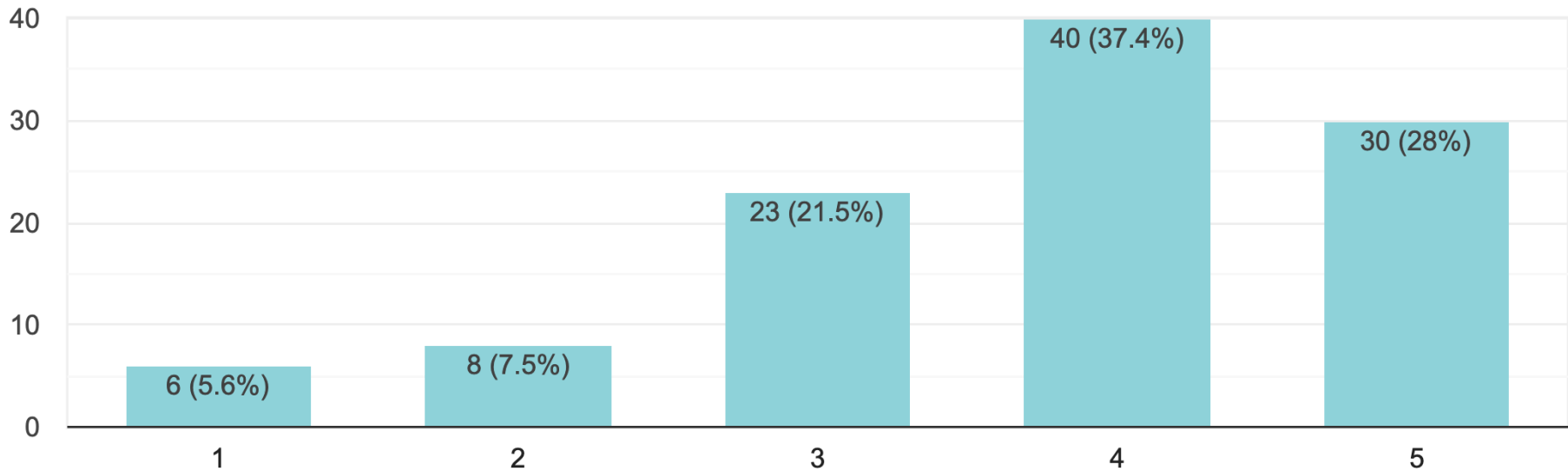

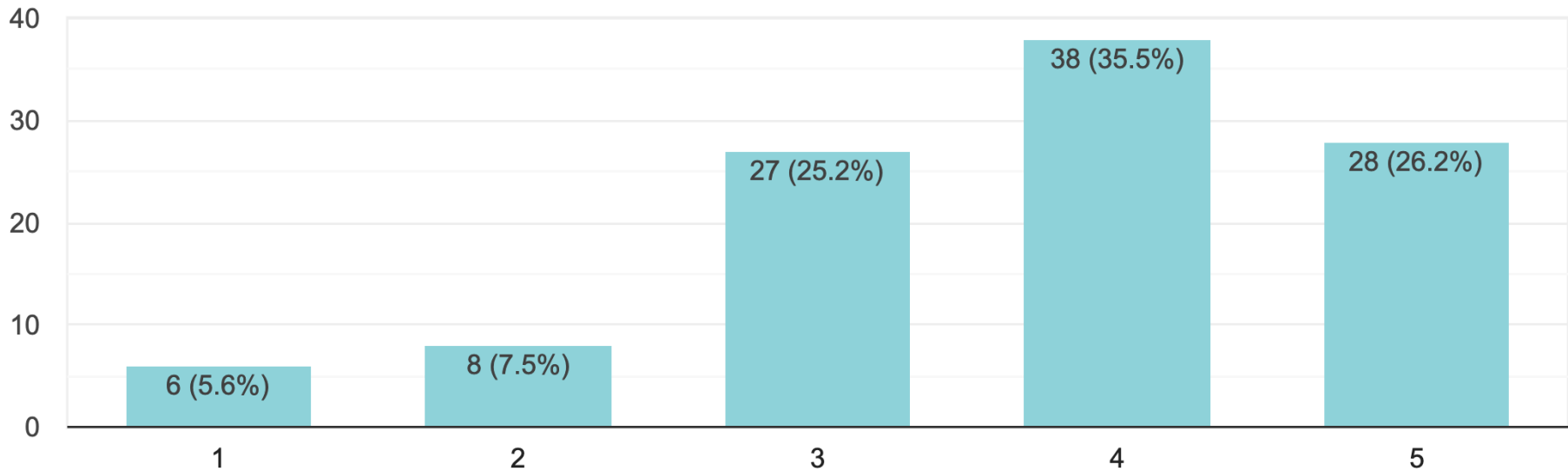
The syllabus generates interest in the subject area

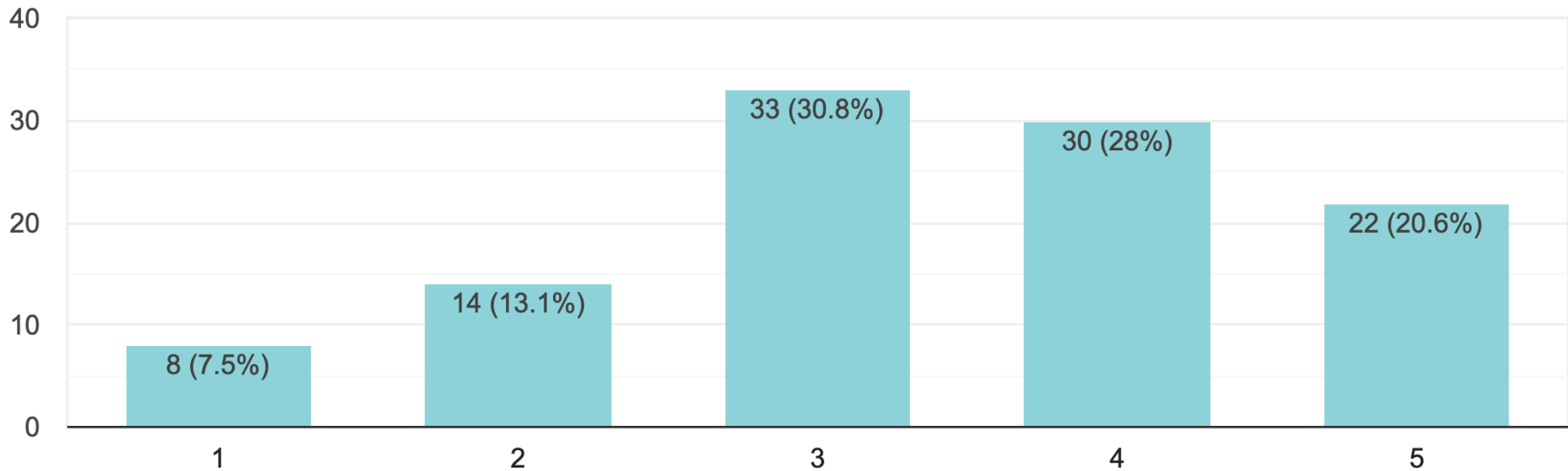

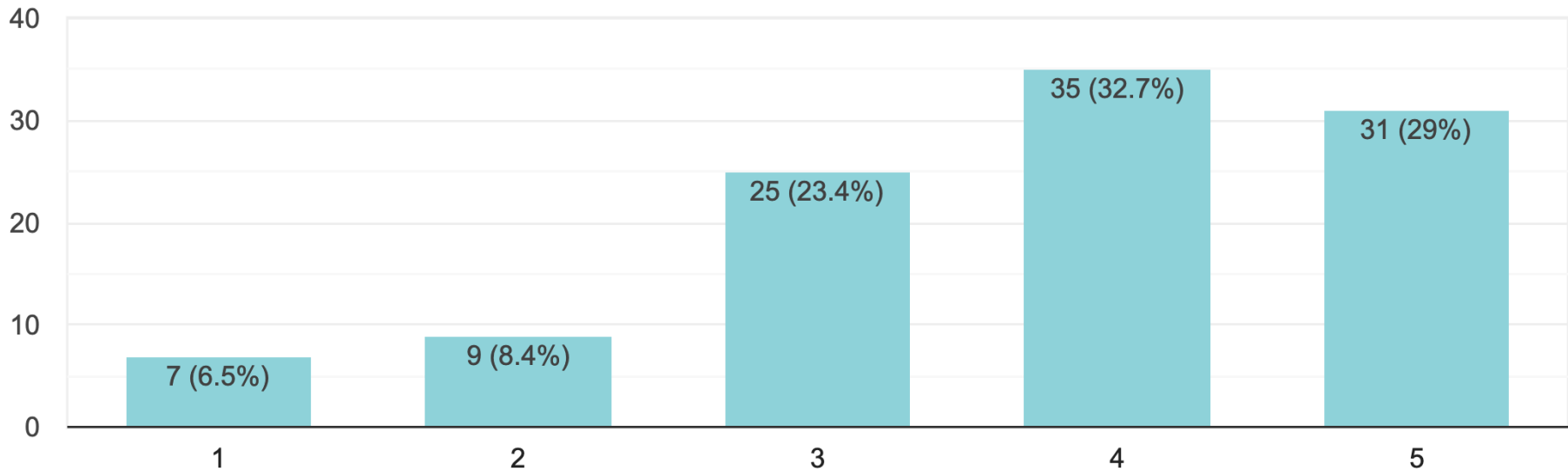
