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Consultancy Policy

The college recognizes that consultancy forms a necessary and essential part of its function as a center for higher learning. Consultancy would encourage a close relationship with the industry, other educational institutions, community and individuals. It fulfills an inevitable and essential part of the higher education and would result in developing mutually beneficial relationships with the society and our College. This policy is intended to provide a clear framework for those faculty members of the college engaged in, or who wish to, engage in consultancy.

- The college encourages faculty members to do consultancy service to support external engagements that facilitate knowledge and technology transfer contributing to economic and social empowerment.
- This policy applies to all faculty and staff of Maharajas College.
- The faculty members involving in the conduct of a consultancy service can avail on-duty for industrial visit and meeting concerned persons for discussion related to the consultancy work.
- The faculty or staff must ensure that the consultancy work does not create a conflict of interest with the functioning of their role in the college.
- Consultancy work is expected to bring financial benefits both to the institution and its employees.
- The revenue generated out of consultancy services will be shared between the college and the faculty members in the following ratio

For utilizing college premises/ equipment's/ research facilities 80 : 20

For providing service using personal expertise of the faculty 20 : 80

The revenue thus generated by the college would be utilized to the development of the concerned department which is represented by the Faculty offering the consultancy

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1. The meeting approved the minutes of the previous governing council meeting.
2. The Controller of Examinations (CE) presented the results of I semester PG (2019 Admission, Regular), III semester UG Regular (2018 Admission), I semester PG (2018 Admission, Improvement/Supplementary), I semester PG (2017 Admission, Improvement/Supplementary), I semester PG (2016 Admission, Supplementary), III semester UG Improvement/Supplementary (2017 Admission), III semester UG Supplementary (2016 Admission) and III semester UG Supplementary (2015 Admission) Examinations and GC approved the results for publication.
3. The Principal presented a request from the II Semester MSc Mathematics students regarding granting moderation during valuation and challenge valuation procedures. The meeting discussed the issue and was of the opinion that the present regulations do not allow the governing council to grant moderation and it was noted that the pass board of the examination concerned has not recommended moderation as well. Any change in the mode of challenge valuation is to be decided by the Academic Council.
4. The meeting approved the request from the Controller of Examinations to utilize the accumulated balance under the CE Accounts for meeting the immediate fund requirements on the condition that the utilized amount shall be refunded when the fund from college office is transferred.
5. The Controller of Examination brought to the notice of the GC that the CE Office has received the copy of the order from MG University, in compliance with the GO, Govt of Kerala to increase the examination fees by 5%. The meeting directed the College Office and the CE Office to implement the above order from the next end semester examination onwards.
6. The meeting decided to constitute a committee to study and report on grace marks to be awarded to various categories of disabled persons. The members include: Dr. Suresh V.N, Controller of Examinations, Dr. K.V Jayamol, Vice-Principal and Dr Shajila Beevi, Member, Governing Council.
7. The Governing Council resolved to approve the submission of the Research Committee Coordinator to constitute a Research Ethics Committee. The Research Policy and the Consultancy Policy of the College were approved and handed over to the Academic Council.
8. Since the nominated member of the UGC to Governing Council stands vacant, the meeting decided to write a letter to the UGC to nominate a member to the Governing Council.
9. Other matters were deferred to the next meeting.
