MINUTES OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL ON 08/08/2019

The academic council began its meeting at 3.45pm at the VIP lounge. The honourable Chairman Dr. K. Jayakumar introduced the new member secretary of the council, Dr. Krishnakumar. K., HoD Botany.

Agenda discussed

1. Reconstitution of the Academic Council

The council decided to send an official letter to the Diretor of Collegiate Education to nominate four teachers of the college to the academic council. It was also resolved to send a letter to the Registrar, Mahatma Gandhi University, to nominate three members to the academic council. In addition, it was also resolved to request the Governing Council to nominate four external experts to the academic council.

The council resolved to submit the list of reconstituted Board of Studies of each

department. HoDs are entrusted to submit the list to the Chairman.

2. Revision of Undergraduate Syllabus

The council discussed the various issues related to UG syllabus revision and entrusted the Chairman of the Board of Studies of each faculty to revise the existing syllabus as per the present rules. It was also decided to incorporate the environmental science in accordance with the syllabus of Mahatma Gandhi University. Attention may also be given to UGC guidelines. The final syllabus should be submitted to the chairman at the third week of September 2019.

The council resolved that an amount of Rs.20000/-(Twenty thousand only) may be granted to each department to meet the expediture related to syllabus revision. The amout may

be allocated from the autonomy grant.

3. The council discussed the working days and attendance of the research scholars and resolved that Saturdays are not working days for the research scholars and should not be considered for attendance as Saturdays are not working days for the departments. However, students can do their work on Saturdays with special permission of the Principal. The council also resolved to strictly monitor the attendance.

Council discussed the issues relating to the half-yearly progress evaluation process of the research scholars and resolved that it should be conducted properly with external experts by the departments concerned and the expediture may be met from the autonomy grant or other research grant available with the college. The council authorised the research coordinator to trace the availability of fund for the same.

Other items permitted by the chair

4. The HoDs of the Music and Philisophy were requested to modify the criteria for admission of students to M.A Music and M.A. Philosophy respectively. The council discussed the matter and resolved to submit a written request to the Chairman. It is also resolved that after obtaining the request necessary modifications will be carried out in the prospectus as the said qualifications were already included in the revised PG syllabus of 2019.

The issues relating to grading, question bank, etc; will be discussed later as the chair would not permitted the matters.

The meeting concluded at 4.45p.m with the briefing of the decisions by the Secretary.

3. Preparation of question bank for examinations

The council discussed the pros and cons of the preparation and introduction of question bank for examinations, and resolved to implement it in 2020 onwards after a thorough preparation.

A draft Prospectus for admission to the M.Sc. Geology recommended by the

Governing council was approved by the council.

A committee was constituted for the preparation of the policies relating to the conduct of the newly sanctioned programme, which includes the Secretary, course coordinator and IQAC coordinator.

The council resolved to intimate the above decisions to the Registrar, Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam and also to nominate a University member to the newly constituted Board of Studies in Geology.

2. Examination related matters

The Secretary briefed the examination related matters. Later the Controller of Examinations Dr. Sivakumar.C explained the matters in detail.

a. Giving attendance to online classes to the students due to COVID-19. The Council resolved that attendance can be given to the students based on the recent direction of the Mahatma Gandhi University ie. by giving additional Seminar/Assignment. The HoDs are directed to conduct the same appropriately.

b. Change in credits of the UG Core course in accordance with the credits of UG core course of the Mahatma Gandhi University. The Council resolved to approve the same. The Board of studies of the concerned faculty will made necessary changes

and inform the same to the Chairman.

- c. Giving additional choices of questions in the question paper due to online classes. The Council resolved to give 20% additional choices to reduce the difficulties of the students due to COVID-19 pandemic. This is applicable only for the regular odd semesters of the academic year 2020-21.
- d. Conversion of CGPA to CCPA The council resolved to approve the recent decision of the Mahatma Gandhi University that the conversion of UG CGPA to CCPA.

e. Change of range of D grade. The council resolved to approve the existing range of D grade (3.5 to 4.5) to D grade (4.0 to 4.5) of the Mahatma Gandhi University.

3. Other matters permitted by the Chair

a. Distribution of weightage to PG practical examination presented by Dr. Rema. L P. The council discussed the matter in detail and entrusted the Board of Studies to take necessary decisions and inform to the Chairman.

The secretary described the existing pattern as well as the proposed pattern of question papers. The council discussed and approved the new pattern of question papers and resolved to inform the matter to Controller of Examinations for immediate effect. 2. Approval of the Board of studies in Integrated PG Programme in Archeology and Material cultural studies.

The Secretary presented the panel of members for the Board of Studies of newly sanctioned integrated programme in Archeology and Material cultural studies. The nominated members were Dr. Vinodkumar Kallolickal, Associate Professor, Dept. of History, Maharaja's College, Sri. Abdul Lathif C.H, Assistant Professor of History, Maharajas's College, Prof. K. Krishnan, Professor and Dean, Faculty of Arts, M S University Baroda, Dr. Ajithkumar, DLRA-F, Kesavadasapuram, Thiruvananthapuram, Dr. Cyriac Jose, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Archeology, St. Thomas College, Pala. Dr. Vinod V, Assistant Professor of Archeology, Mar Thoma College for Women, Perumbavoor, Sri. Jenee Peter, Assistant Professor of History, UC College, Aluva, Dr. V R Shaji, Conservation Officer, Centre for Heritage Studies, Hill Palace, Thrippunithura, Dr. B. Venugopal, Honorary Director, Centre for Intangible Heritage, SSUS, Kalady. The Council has also resolved to send a letter to the Registrar. Mahatma Gandhi University to nominate the University nominee to the newly constituted Board of Studies.

3. Discussion and approval of the syllabus of the newly sanctioned Integrated Programme in Archaeology and Material Cultural Studies.

A draft syllabus was prepared by a committee of experts under the convenorship of the Secretary constituted by the Chairman was presented in the Council. The council discussed and resolved that, as minor modifications are required hence the newly constituted Board of Studies should go through the Syllabus for suggested modifications. Based on this the Council resolved the following. 1. Programme Outcome evaluation questions must be included in the question papers for both UG and PG. 2. Internal evaluation examination schedule to be included in the examination calendar. 3. All Board of Studies should include at least one add-on course in the curriculum.

8. PG Syllabus revision

The existing PG Syllabus should be revised based on the Outcome Based Education for 2021 admission.

MINUTES OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL ON 09/06/2021

The academic council began its meeting at 3.00pm in online mode due to COVID-19 pandemic. The honorable Chairman Dr. Mathew George, Principal welcomed the members and presented the agenda. The secretary Dr. Krishnakumar. K, Associate Professor presented the agenda in detail on behalf of the Chairman and opened for discussion.

Agenda Discussed.

1. Approval of the Academic Calendar 2021-'22.

Secretary presented the Academic Calendar prepared by a committee for the year 2021-22 and informed to the Council that it was prepared with utmost care to avoid the extension of the semesters to vacation period as well as the duration of the programmes. The members discussed it in detail and modified the commencement of classes of the III semester of the UG (2020 admission) and PG (2020 admission) from 09/07/2021 to 02/08/2021 and subsequent semesters were modified accordingly and approved the Calendar.

2. Conduct of End semester examination and valuation due to COVID-19 pandemic.

The council resolved to approve the off-campus examination centers in different districts and Controller of Examination is entrusted to organize the same based on the need of the candidates.

The Council resolved to approve the change of the existing double valuation of the end semester examination due to COVID19 pandemic as follows. Only 20% of the answer books are randomly selected and subjected for external valuation. Due to change in the evaluation system students are allowed to apply for revaluation as per the existing rules of the Mahatma Gandhi University. This change in the valuation system is due to COVID-19 pandemic and applicable to the current semesters only.

The Project evaluation and viva-voce of the VI semester UG and IV semester PG to be conducted internally in online mode. A minimum of two examiners should be in the board in addition to the HoD of the concerned department.

- 3. Award of bonus mark to the students graduated from Maharaja's college for PG admission. The Council discussed the matter in detail and resolved that it can't be implemented as it was not practiced in autonomous colleges. Council suggested to approach Autonomous approval committee/University for its feasibility.
- 4. The Board of Studies of Economics(H) and Political Science submitted a proposal to the Chairman to change the calculation of the index mark for the UG admission. The Council resolved to approve the same and approach the University for Necessary Orders.
- 5. The Convenor of the Admission (2021-22) Committee submitted a proposal to the Chairman as follows. Enhancement of admission fee, Reduction in number of options in the application from 5 to 3, Appointment of technical committee, verification of certificates, Arts and Sports quota mode of application. The Council resolved that the option for admission to be maintained as 5 as per the existing prospectus. The other matters were not in the purview of the Council.

The Convenor of the question bank preparation Committee Dr. Rema L.P reported the progress of the question bank preparation on request of the Secretary.

The meeting concluded at 4.30p.m with the briefing of the decisions by the Secretary.
