

MINUTES OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL ON 09/06/2021

The academic council began its meeting at 3.00pm in online mode due to COVID-19 pandemic. The honorable Chairman Dr. Mathew George, Principal welcomed the members and presented the agenda. The secretary Dr. Krishnakumar. K, Associate Professor presented the agenda in detail on behalf of the Chairman and opened for discussion.

Agenda Discussed.

1. Approval of the Academic Calendar 2021-'22.

Secretary presented the Academic Calendar prepared by a committee for the year 2021-22 and informed to the Council that it was prepared with utmost care to avoid the extension of the semesters to vacation period as well as the duration of the programmes. The members discussed it in detail and modified the commencement of classes of the III semester of the UG (2020 admission) and PG (2020 admission) from 09/07/2021 to 02/08/2021 and subsequent semesters were modified accordingly and approved the Calendar.

2. Conduct of End semester examination and valuation due to COVID-19 pandemic.

The council resolved to approve the off-campus examination centers in different districts and Controller of Examination is entrusted to organize the same based on the need of the candidates.

The Council resolved to approve the change of the existing double valuation of the end semester examination due to COVID19 pandemic as follows. Only 20% of the answer books are randomly selected and subjected for external valuation. Due to change in the evaluation system students are allowed to apply for revaluation as per the existing rules of the Mahatma Gandhi University. This change in the valuation system is due to COVID-19 pandemic and applicable to the current semesters only.

The Project evaluation and viva-voce of the VI semester UG and IV semester PG to be conducted internally in online mode. A minimum of two examiners should be in the board in addition to the HoD of the concerned department.

3. **Award of bonus mark to the students graduated from Maharaja's college for PG admission.** The Council discussed the matter in detail and resolved that it can't be implemented as it was not practiced in autonomous colleges. Council suggested to approach Autonomous approval committee/University for its feasibility.

4. **The Board of Studies of Economics(H) and Political Science submitted a proposal to the Chairman to change the calculation of the index mark for the UG admission.** The Council resolved to approve the same and approach the University for Necessary Orders.

5. **The Convenor of the Admission (2021-22) Committee submitted a proposal to the Chairman as follows.** Enhancement of admission fee, Reduction in number of options in the application from 5 to 3, Appointment of technical committee, verification of certificates, Arts and Sports quota mode of application. The Council resolved that the option for admission to be maintained as 5 as per the existing prospectus. The other matters were not in the purview of the Council.

The Convenor of the question bank preparation Committee Dr. Rema L.P reported the progress of the question bank preparation on request of the Secretary.

The meeting concluded at 4.30p.m with the briefing of the decisions by the Secretary.

Agenda Discussed.

1. Examination related matters informed by the Controller of Examinations.

a. Pattern of 5th Semester (2019 admission) Question paper and Supplementary Examination.

It was discussed and resolved that the liberalized pattern followed in the 4th semester is to be followed for the 5th semester examination also due to online classes due to COVID-19 pandemic, however for the Supplementary examination the old pattern (non COVID – 19) to be followed.

b. Conduct of external evaluation.


Due to COVID-19 pandemic only 20% of the answer scripts were subjected for external evaluation. The Council thoroughly discussed the matter and resolved that the present system to be followed with a centralized valuation camp. Due to strong arguments, a committee was constituted to study the pros and cons of the 100% and 20% external valuation system and prepare a report and submit to the Chairman of the Council. The members of the committee are Dr. Suresh V N (HoD Commerce), Dr. N. Shaji (External Member) and Dr. Bloomy Joseph (HoD Mathematics).


c. Conduct of Practical Examinations.

Due to COVID-19 pandemic both the UG and PG Practicals/Vivavoce/Project were evaluated by internal examiners only. It was resolved that the Practicals/Vivavoce/Project shall be evaluated by One external and One internal examiner for the examinations that is to be conducted from 1 November 2021 onwards.

2. Change in the distribution of weightage in practical examinations of Chemistry and Zoology presented by concerned Chairmen of the Board of Studies. Resolved to approve the change.
3. Admission criteria of Music – Approved, to be communicated to the Mahatma Gandhi University for ratification.
4. Preparation of the Comprehensive Academic Calender– The Academic Calendar for the academic year 2021-22 was approved in the Council meeting conducted on 09.06.2021. However, based on the suggestion of the NAAC peer team the Council resolved to prepare a comprehensive Academic Calendar which include the dates of In semester examinations as well as the tentative dates of publication of result of each examinations. The Calendar has to be prepared under the Convener'ship of IQAC Coordinator. Member Secretary, Controller of Examinations, Academic Monitoring Committee as well as the present Committee involved in the preparation of College Calendar are other members.
5. As permitted by the Chair the Council resolved to represent the grievance of the totally blind students for giving additional grace marks to the End Semester examinations after obtaining consent from the University.

The meeting concluded at 4.50p.m with the briefing of the decisions by the Secretary.

MINUTES OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL ON 04/02/2022

The academic council began its meeting at 7.30pm in online mode due to COVID-19 pandemic. The honorable Chairman Dr. Pooja P Balasundaram, Principal welcomed the members. The secretary Dr. Krishnakumar. K, Associate Professor presented the agenda in detail on behalf of the Chairman and opened for discussion.

Agenda Discussed.

1. Examination related matters informed by the Controller of Examinations.

a. Pattern of liberalized pattern of question papers for the academic year 2021-22 as per the letter of the Mahatma Gandhi University.

It was decided in the meeting on 06/10/2021 that the liberalized pattern to be followed in the 5th semester UG examinations except for supplementary examinations. It was discussed and resolved that the liberalized pattern of question papers to be followed in the 2021-22 academic year as per the direction of the Mahatma Gandhi University.

b. Conduct of Practicals, Project Viva and Comprehensive viva voce examinations during the academic year 2021-22 due to COVID 19 pandemic.

It was discussed in detail and resolved the following:

1. Both UG and PG Practicals and Project viva has to be conducted by at least two internal examiners.

2. The project viva of both UG and PG can be conducted online.

3. For PG projects a two stage evaluation may be followed for the fruitful completion of the project, and for comprehensive viva one external examiner to be in the board in addition to one internal examiner.

4. Plagiarism checking has to be adopted as a desirable practice in the PG projects.

c. Issue of Provisional Degree Certificate and Migration Certificates.

As per the communication from the Mahatma Gandhi University (Order No. 6020/AC B7/2021/MGU dated 12.11.2021) Autonomous colleges were authorized to issue the Provisional degree certificate and Migration certificates to the students. It was resolved that these certificates can be issued to the students from 2021-22 academic year by the Controller of Examinations on fulfilling other stipulations.

d. Modification of the MC PGP-CSS 2019 regulation for the conduct of Comprehensive Viva-voce.

As per the order No. 4054/AC A9/2021/MGU dated 17.08.2021 of Mahatma Gandhi University modified the PG CSS Regulation 2019. It was discussed and the following amendments were incorporated in the MC PGPCSS-2019 regulations:

Comprehensive Viva-voce:

Components	Internal (CE) Weight	External (ESE) Weight
Basic knowledge and Presentation skills	1	3
Topic of interest	1	3
Knowledge of core courses	3	9
Total	5	15

These basic components can be subdivided if necessary

2. Presentation of the report of the Reforms in the regulations of valuation of answer scripts of End Semester Examinations of UG and PG examinations.

A committee was constituted under the Chairmanship of Dr. Dinesh. V.N, HoD Commerce in the Academic council meeting on 06.10.2021. The submitted report was exhaustively



discussed and resolved the following:

1. 100% internal evaluation and 20% of the answer scripts undergone internal evaluation were randomly selected and to be subjected for external evaluation.
2. The chief valuation to be continued. The HoDs should ensure the effective and timely chief evaluation.
3. If the difference in marks/weightage obtained (in 1st and 2nd valuation) is more than 20% of the maximum marks/weightage, then such answer scripts should be valued further by a different internal examiner. The average of the 3rd valuation and nearest to it (scored in 1st or 2nd valuation) will be the final marks/weightage.
4. If 50% or more of the externally valued answer scripts of any course shows 20% variation in marks/weightage, the marks/weightage of the courses to be disclosed (only after 3rd valuation of all answer scripts by an internal examiner) to the concerned HoD by the Controller of Examinations (CE) for its appraisal. If the mistake was from the external examiner, the matter is to be informed to the CE, if by the internal examiner proper warning to be given by the HoD. The details of external examiner should not be disclosed under any circumstances.
5. The Council also suggested a periodical appraisal of the evaluation by a team external examiners.
6. The present revaluation system is to be followed.

3. Modification of Syllabus of B.A English proposed by the Department of English.

Marginal changes in the Modules and hour distribution in 3, 4, 5 and 6th semesters of B.A English was recommended by the Board of studies on 11.11.2021 was approved and recommended to communicate to the Mahatma Gandhi University.


4. Approval of the Syllabus of the Integrated Programme in Archeology and Material Cultural Studies.

The Board of Studies of the Archeology and Material Cultural Studies finalized the Syllabus on 18.01.2022 and requested to approve the Syllabus of the Programme. It was discussed and resolved to approve and forward the same to the Mahatma Gandhi University. The secretary suggested to obtain the clarifications from University regarding the exit provision from the course on completion of 3 years as well as the regulations regarding Integrated Programme.

5. Inclusion of the Internship in the PG programme

It was already decided to include the Internship in the PG Programme 2022 admission onwards. It was resolved that a minimum of 10 days internship to be completed by each student before the completion of the 4th Semester. Necessary amendments to be done in the MC PGP-CSS Regulations 2019.

The meeting was concluded at 9.30pm with the briefing of the decisions by the Secretary.

MINUTES OF THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL ON 21/04/2022

The academic council began its meeting at 3.00pm via online mode. The honorable Chairman Dr. V. Anil., Principal welcomed the members and presented the agenda. The secretary Dr. Krishnakumar. K, Associate Professor presented the agenda in detail on behalf of the Chairman and opened for discussion.

Agenda Discussed.

1. Approval of the PG Regulation and revised Syllabi of the PG programmes (2022 admission onwards)

As per the decision of the Academic Council on 10.03.2021 the Board of Studies(BoS) of the Arabic, Botany, Chemistry, Commerce, English, Economics, History, Hindi, Islamic History, Mathematics, Malayalam, Music, Physics, Political science, Philosophy, Sanskrit, Statistics, Zoology and Geology revised their Syllabi and presented it before the Academic Council.

The Secretary informed that one of the external member Prof. (Dr.) K G. Poulouse has an inconvenience in attending the meeting hence his suggestions will be communicated to the Council via email, also announced that the concerned Chairman of the BoS should note the suggestions of the external members as it was purely related to the Programme concerned and incorporate the same accordingly. The council exhaustively discussed each restructured syllabus. The Chairman of each BoS presented the revised Syllabus. While on discussion the following suggestions were made by the external members. Prof. (Dr.) Jayachandran, School of Biosciences, MG University suggested the inclusion of rubrics in the implementation of Outcome Based Education (OBE). The Secretary give an assurance that it will be discussed in the next Council after a thorough discussion with the internal members. Dr. N. Shaji suggested the feasibility of provision for common course for different programmes, he strongly discouraged the inclusion of Astrology in the Syllabus of Sanskrit, also suggested the inclusion of western music in Music Syllabus. Prof. (Dr.) Beena Mathew, School of Chemical Sciences suggested some modifications in the Electrochemistry. Dr. Ajithkumar. Suggested the modifications in the Syllabi of Economics and Statistics. After the thorough discussion the Council resolved to approve and recommended the PG Regulation and Syllabi of various PG Programmes mentioned above.

Dr. Shinas P A and Dr. N. Shaji have suggested the setting of question papers by the internal faculty. The secretary informed to the Council that this shall be implemented during the question bank preparation in connection with the conduct of End semester examinations.

The Chairman as well as the Secretary informed to the Council that the restructured Syllabus of the Geology programme was not followed certain components of the OBE hence require a modification, thus the Council resolved that the BoS should follow the OBE and shall incorporate the same and the Chairman of the Council is entrusted to approve the Syllabus after the modification suggested by the Council.

2. Approval of the Academic Calendar 2022-23.

The Secretary presented the Academic Calendar 2022-23 which was communicated to all members. Dr. Angel Mathew of Statistics informed that the I UG and I PG won't be able to start on June 2022. Dr. Sunilkumar S Menon of Economics and Dr. Suresh V. N of Commerce also expressed the same concern as well as suggested to extend certain Semesters for completing the Syllabi. Dr. Bloomy Joseph of Mathematics suggested that the Calendar is not realistic because the Syllabus won't be completed especially for the running IV Semester of PG. She also requested the Chairman of the Council to reduce



some portions of the Syllabi. The Secretary informed to the Council that the Academic Calendar was prepared in such a way that the vacation days were excluded. The Chairman given a detailed narration on every matters presented, also informed that minor changes may be permitted for commencement of I UG and I PG 2022 admission. This will be taken only after the 2022 admission. The Council resolved to approve the Academic Calendar of 2022-23.

3. Correction in the Prospectus of 2022 UG/PG admission.

The BoS of Islamic History and History submitted a letter to the Chairman that certain errors were noted in the Prospectus. Hence it is resolved to modify as follows and effective in the 2022 admission.
