
easy reference of the entire syllabus will be beneficial to the student to follow syllabus structure. Basic reference should be decided according to the content and better to define the application level of learning process.









Dr. V .K. Vijayakumar: highlighted the importance of discussing the theoretical concepts in connection with real world experiences.


