A three-storied academic block and a new library block was inaugurated in the academic year 2020-21.

Academic Planning

The Academic Council, The IQAC, The internal examination Committee, and The Controller of Examinations organized a meeting before the commencement of the academic year to draft an action plan for that academic year. The Schedules for the BOS, Academic Council, and Governing Council meetings, time-bound conducting of examinations, etc. are also planned. The academic, co-curricular, and extra-curricular activities for each academic year are also planned well in advance.

Review of Teaching-Learning Process

The College reviews the teaching-learning process, structures, and methodologies of operation and learning outcomes at periodic intervals through the IQAC. At the end of every semester, the teacher collects feedback from students for self-improvement. After the publication of the result of semester exams, the result is analyzed Department wise and corrective measures are executed for the betterment of the result. After the end Semester, examination feedback is collected from students about the curriculum, attainment of graduate attributes. Department-level induction/orientation programmes were arranged for newly joined students.

A new timetable is prepared for online classes in compliance with the master timetable considering the time restriction suggested by the DCE. For the smooth conduct of online classes, the College provided official mail id. for all the faculty members and students. The UG syllabus revision was completed incorporating the suggestions from all the stakeholders and implemented in the 2020-21 academic year. A new course related to the environment is introduced in all the UG programmes. All the first-year UG students were enrolled in the Swayam Portal

The SQAC was formed, nominating the toppers in each class of the department for assuring the quality of the students in academic and non-academic matters. The tutorial system and Mentoring system were also taken up to help students in various ways. With the help of various committees and organizations, needy students were equipped to cope with the online classes. With the help of the Jeevani centre all measures were taken to monitor the mental health of all students and provided counseling support to students in need. In the wake of the Pandemic Situation, all measures were taken to strengthen the tutorial system and Mentoring System. Remedial Teaching is imparted to weaker students based on the result analysis report. Applying Scientific Methods Slow and Advanced Learners were identified and special programmes were arranged for all category students. Making use of Google form survey on graduate attributes was conducted.

IQAC Initiatives in managing the online teaching-learning process

The institution has an e-learning platform-Moodle, which enabled the teachers to share their e-resources with students. Teachers are also using Google meet and Zoom platforms for conducting online classes. Teachers and students are encouraged to attend MOOC courses offered through different platforms like Swayam and NPTEL. High-speed wireless internet connectivity provided on the Campus allows students and teachers to access unlimited internet.

IQAC of Maharaja's College organized a seven-day training programme on Moodle LMS as part of the implementation of LMS. The Cell organized a training programme on e-Content Development for all faculty members. With the help of the Website Committee, the College issued an N-list password for all students to Access N-list E-library. Making use of different online platforms like g-suite, MOODLE, etc. All the faculty members effectively handled the leaching learning and evaluation activities. 100 rare books in the College Library were digitalized and shared with D-space and archive.org. In association with IQAC, all the Departments conducted International Webinar series and live-streamed using the newly

purchased live streaming studio. College is registered as the NPTEL local chapter of SWAYAM. More than 1500 students registered for various courses through this portal.

Examination

The covid pandemic situation that prevailed during that time delayed the conduct of examinations and declaration of results. Because of the limitations in transport and accommodation facilities and also to minimize exposure of students to the epidemic, offcampus examination centres were set up in almost all districts of the state. Then government colleges in various districts were designated as off-campus examination centres, taking permission from the authorities concerned with each centre. Faculty members of the college were deputed to conduct the examination in each centre. Required number of question papers, answer sheets, and other examination materials were additionally prepared and sent to each centre on time. After examinations, the answer scripts and other examination materials were taken back to the college for evaluation. All examinations halls in the college were sanitized and are equipped with hand sanitizers. The invigilators were given gloves. The temperature of all students is taken on all days of examination at college gates. To minimize contact with hands, the signatures of students were not taken on the forms used in the examination halls. The number of candidates in each hall was reduced for ensuring physical distancing among candidates. This process increased the number of examination halls and the number of invigilators. Special examination halls were set up for those candidates with covid-19 symptoms. The answer scripts were kept in quarantine in such cases, before valuation. Internal assessment examinations, viva-voce and project evaluation were conducted online The regular students of all UG programmes (2018 Admissions) and PG programmes (2019 Admissions) completed all their semester-end examinations and their final results were published on 30th June 2020 and 13th July 2020 respectively. The UG regulations were revised for the second time with effect from 2020 admission to the UG programmes onward, completely switching to outcome-based education. Due to uncertainties arising out of the pandemic and lockdowns, such a comprehensive examination schedule could not be prepared in advance during the academic year. However, notifications for all examinations during the period were published well in advance for the convenience of the candidates. The SAY examinations for all courses of semester V and semester VI of all UG programmes are conducted for the final year UG regular students after the publication of results of semester VI. The results are published immediately, taking special efforts, so that the passing students can apply for PG programmes without losing a year waiting for the next supplementary examinations The special re-examination was held in view of the benefit of those regular candidates who could not attend the examination due to covid-19 pandemic.

Research Activities

The 18th department of the College is also recognized as the Research Department. Seven more teachers are recognized as Research guides. Nineteen research Scholars enrolled in various Research Departments during this Academic year. All research scholars presented their research progress and the live streaming of these events arranged using the newly purchased live streaming studio. A publication wall has been arranged in the College to exhibit the publication of teachers and students. The Research committee organized Course

work classes through an online platform. Seven Research scholars were awarded with Ph.D. during the academic year 2020-21.

Cocurricular activities during the pandemic period


