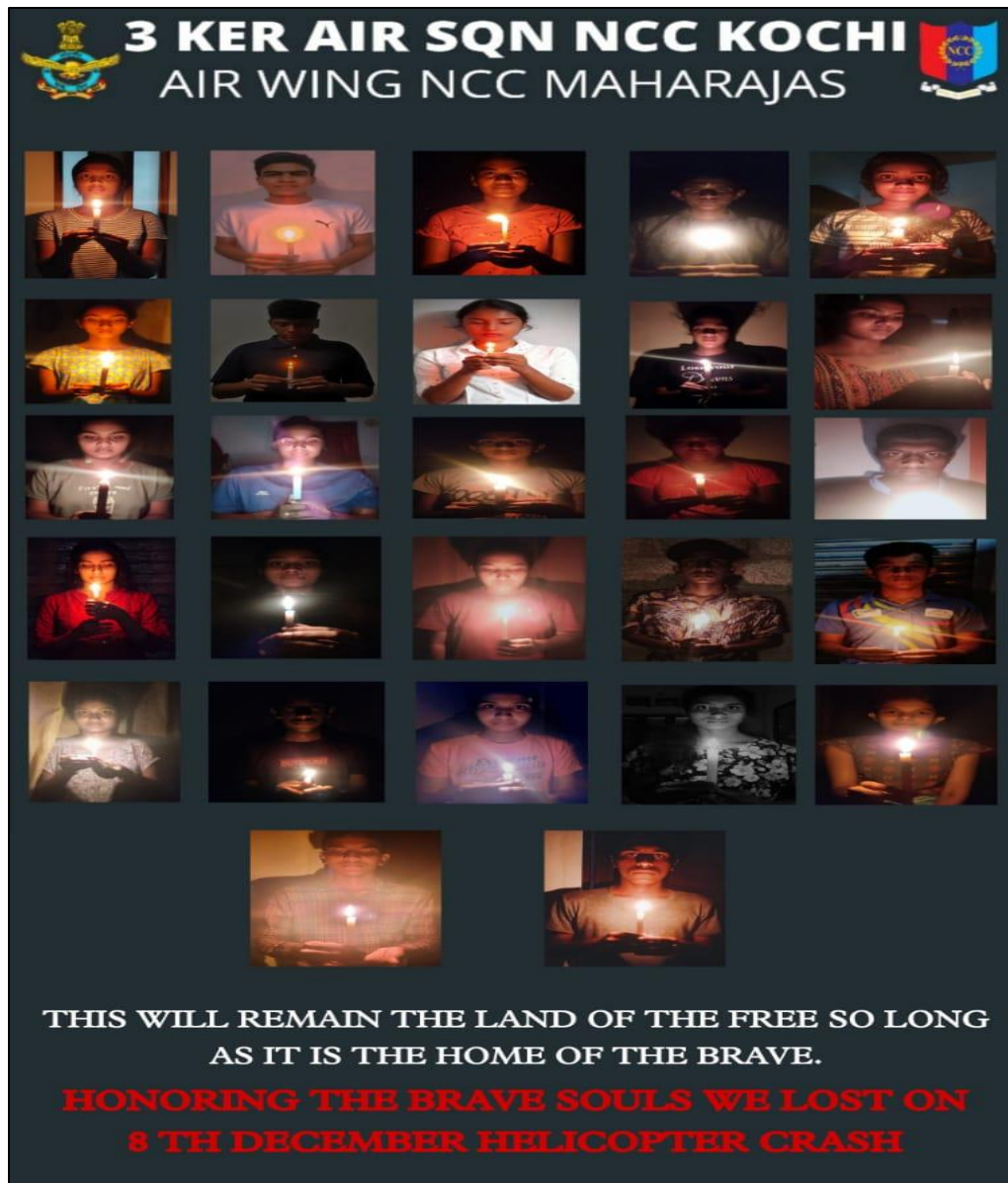
TRAINING ACTIVITIES DAY CELEBRATIONS **AND SOCIAL SERVICES.**

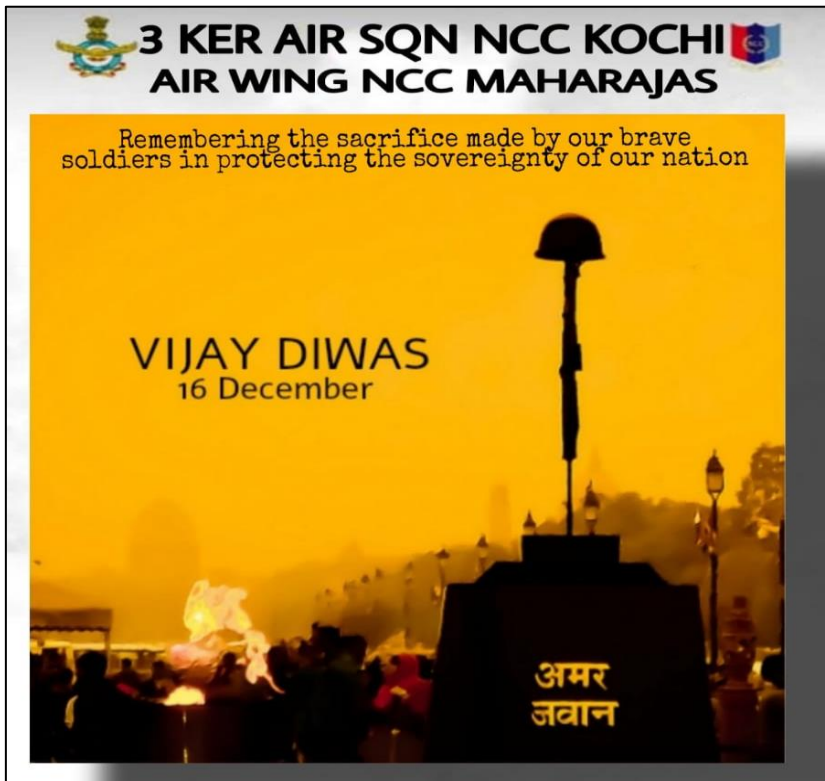

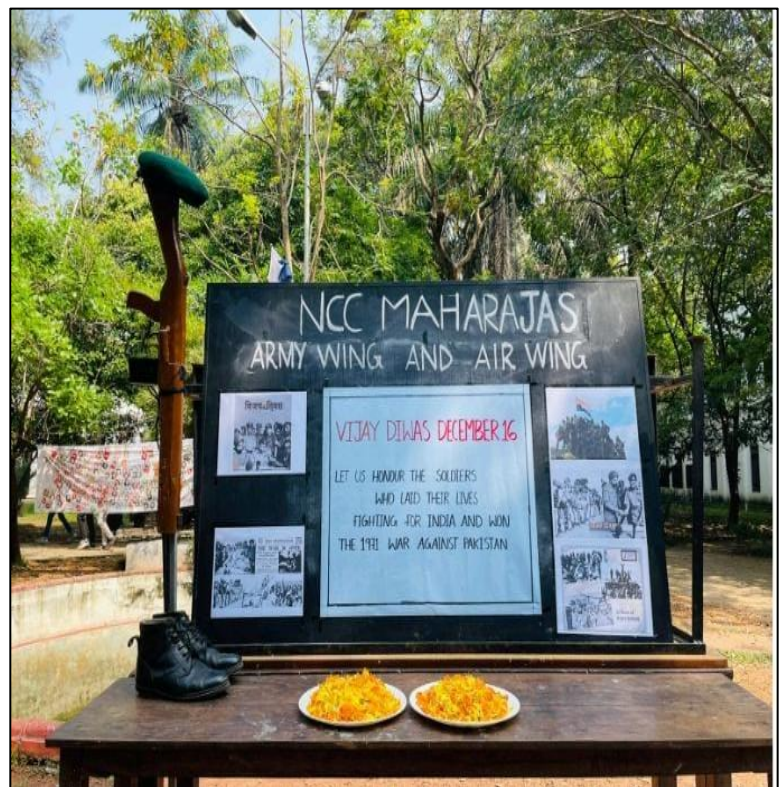
