This title was won by fighting inflation.

We were able to organize a PG day and college day called 'Ponyar' for post graduate students.

As part of the union intervention, it was possible to get permission for a toilet complex and hand over the responsibility to the PWD to address the inadequacy of toilets faced by the students in the campus.


The Union has also been able to modernize various labs in the campus over time.
